

EMPLOYMENT IN OUR AREA

Weston College plays an integral role in the skills agenda within the South West region. The College itself is part of the West of England Local Enterprise Partnership (North Somerset, BANES, Bristol, and South Gloucestershire), but with such a wide catchment area it is also a key contributor to the Heart of the South West partnership (Somerset and Devon).

The West of England is a great place to be located as the region competes on a global scale where highly skilled people work, where ideas flourish, and where businesses grow.

Key benefits include:

- Over 45.000 businesses.
- At the leading edge of innovation with world-class offers in design, culture, trade, shipping, engineering, aerospace, microelectronics, composites, robotics, green technologies, social enterprise, connectivity, and digital creativity.
- 48% of workplace employees are managers, directors, and senior officials.
- Jobs growth of over 51,000 in the last 5 years - projected to grow by over 17,000 in the next 5 years.
- The top 5 employment sectors in the region are currently: Construction, Health, Education, Scientific Services and Professional Services.

- Across Health and Social care, there are over 3,500 employers in the region with the Adult social care sector alone employing around 24,000 people.

A new report has revealed that salaries in Bristol are 3% above the UK average. HINKLEY POINT

Hinkley Point C will create 25,000 employment and apprenticeship opportunities in a broad range of occupations and careers during its construction and operation. There will be jobs in construction, civil engineering, electrical installation, hospitality, catering, logistics, security, site services, support roles and others over the coming years, and it's not just during construction.

Hinkley Point C will have an expected workforce of 900 people to run the power station throughout its 60-year operation and is scheduled to start operating in 2027.

Early estimates suggest that Hinkley Point C could save the UK population £1bn in energy bills.

GREEN SKILLS

The West of England has set an ambitious goal for tackling climate change, committing to net zero carbon by 2030.

Green skills encompass the expertise that we need to develop and support a sustainable society. Low-carbon jobs currently represent less than 1% of all jobs (6,250 out of 7,000,000) in the West of England. However, the potential for green job creation is significant. For the region to meet net zero by 2030, more than 50,000 new jobs would be required.

- 52% of projected additional low-carbon jobs will be in construction and installation.
- 38% of low carbon jobs will be in operation and maintenance to support the transition to net zero.
- 10% of additional low carbon jobs will be manufacturing-based, building on the region's strong capabilities in aerospace and engineering.

As a result, sustainability and green skills are now a fundamental part of all Weston College study programmes.

QUALIFICATIONS EXPLAINED

At Weston College we know that everyone learns differently. That's why we deliver a variety of different qualification types - to give you the chance to learn in the way that suits you the most.

A LEVELS

A Levels develop the knowledge, skills and study habits to excel at university, as well as the attributes recognised by employers. Your academic studies will be complemented with enrichment opportunities such as trips, mentoring and work experience, providing the perfect springboard for your future career. A Levels are assessed through exams at the end of two years of study. Most learners study three subjects - some choose four.

APPRENTICESHIPS

With an apprenticeship you'll go straight into the workplace and be shown clear routes to progress straight into employment within a specific occupation. You can achieve nationally recognised qualifications, earn a wage, and gain skills that will see you get ahead. On average you will spend 20% of your learning time in the college and 80% within the workplace.

TRAINEESHIPS

Traineeships are a great way for 16 to 24-year-olds who haven't yet gained the skills and experiences necessary to apply for jobs and apprenticeships. They are taught mostly in the workplace and include a mixture of personal and social development, and employability skills. The aim of a traineeship is to train you within a company so that you are more likely to be offered an apprenticeship or a job.

PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL

Professional and technical qualifications are designed to provide you with the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to gain employment within specific industries or occupations. They provide a balance between theory and practical skills development. They are suited to those who want to get hands-on experience within a particular vocational area. These programmes include work placements. Assessment is more varied and will include exams, coursework and practical work.

T-LEVELS

T Levels are part of the government reforms to technical qualifications at Level 3 and are seen as the 'gold' standard and best choice for learners looking for a college-based route into higher technical occupations and jobs. T Levels have been designed with leading businesses and employers to give you the knowledge and skills you need. This qualification gives you the chance to learn what a real career is like while you continue your studies. You will have an industry placement that will last for at least 45 days.

If you're academically strong but you have a skilled career route in mind, a T Level is the qualification for you.

LEVELS EXPLAINED

FOUNDATION LEVEL

These pre-vocational programmes are an introduction to a wide range of options in order for you to make an informed choice regarding your chosen vocational area.

DURATION 1-3 YEARS

REQUIREMENTS

For those with no formal qualifications or who have GCSE outcomes at grade 2 and below. Ideal for learners who might need a differentiated programme of training, and where support may be needed to successfully access learning at a higher level.

PROGRESSION

You can progress to one or a combination of the following:

- Higher level programmes such as Level 1
- Supported internships
- Employment
- Independent living

LEVEL 1

Level 1 study programmes develop the key skills and learning behaviours necessary for you to successfully progress to a level 2 programme, traineeship or apprenticeship. They provide a particular focus on maths, English and personal development skills.

DURATION 1 YEAR

REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of five GCSEs at grade 3-1, with at least two at grade 3, or the successful completion of a pre-vocational programme or entry level programme after pre-vocational.

PROGRESSION

With this level of qualification you could move onto a Level 2 study programme or an apprenticeship at Level 2. Options include:

- Technical qualifications such as diplomas, certificates and NVQs at level 2
- Transition to T Level Programme
- Intermediate apprenticeships

The table below shows typical entry requirements for each study programme level, although your chosen programme may have specific criteria so, please look at specific study programs on our website to confirm.

LEVEL 2

Level 2 study programmes equip you with the skills you need for a specific career. You will start to specialise in the areas you find most interesting but the qualifications are still broad enough to give you a wide range of progression opportunities if you're not sure what you'd like to do in the future.

DURATION 1 YEAR

REQUIREMENTS

A minimum 5 GCSE grade 9-2 with at least two at grade 4 or a qualifying Level 1 qualification with identified competence level achieved in maths and English.

PROGRESSION

With this level of qualification you could move onto a Level 3 study programme, into a job with training, or an apprenticeship at Level 3. Options include:

- A Levels
- T Levels
- Advanced apprenticeship

LEVEL 3

Level 3 study programmes usually last one or two years, and offer more specialised, advanced learning which give you the skills and knowledge to progress directly into a job, a higher apprenticeship or university level course.

DURATION 2 YEARS

REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of 5 GCSE grade 9-4 or a qualifying Level 2 qualification with identified competence level achieved in maths and English. Please note that some of our level 3 qualifications have additional entry criteria. All of these can be found on the programme's webpage.

PROGRESSION

With this level of qualification you could progress into skilled employment or a range of further study options such as:

- Foundation Degrees (Level 4)
- Bachelor Degrees (Level 5/6)
- Higher and Degree apprenticeships (From Level 4)
- HNDs (Level 4)
- Professional qualifications at level 4 and above

University Centre Weston (UCW) offers around 50 degree level courses.

WHAT IS A STUDY PROGRAMME?

Study programmes are designed to meet your individual learning needs and prepare you for higher learning, training, or employment. Your timetable at college will be made up of a number of different elements that have been sequenced to help you develop the knowledge, skills, and behaviours you will need in the future. We want you to be confident and ready to meet the demands of learning, work, and life. Each study programme is made up of the following core elements:

1. THE QUALIFICATION

A significant portion of your timetable will be dedicated to you achieving this.

2. ENGLISH AND MATHS DEVELOPMENT

If you didn't get a grade 4 at GCSE in maths and/or English, you will complete GCSE or a Functional Skill in these subjects as part of your study programme.

3. WORK OR INDUSTRY PLACEMENT

As part of a Career Excellence Hub, you will carry out work experience or an industry placement to gain the first-hand experience that you need to stand out from the crowd in the employment market - this can be up to 315 hours. Many students have gained employment directly from an industry placement and they provide an opportunity to apply your learning from college.

4. TUTORIAL AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

This builds the behaviours, attitudes, and personal skills you will need to thrive in both work and society. Centred on six key themes, the programme develops a core set of skills and attitudes through a range of projects, activities and learning opportunities. All students also have a regular one-to-one tutorial with their personal tutor. The aim of the tutorial is to monitor your progress and give you the support you need to achieve your personal and academic targets.

5. ESSENTIAL DIGITAL SKILLS

All programmes will include essential digital skills development. These are designed to help you get ready for the world of work and improve your ability to work digitally and use technology confidently. Digital skills will be developed through projects. You will use a range of digital tools to complete these. Many programmes have accreditation built in for these skills e.g. Microsoft accreditation.

6. LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM WITH LIBRARYPLUS

You will have access to a range of learning spaces and resources in our vibrant LibraryPlus learning centres. Supported by our dedicated Learning Advisor team it includes a variety of spaces for group work or individual study, plus resources for your subject, self-service laptops, tablets, PCs and more. Our LibraryPlus team can also support with research and study skills, as well as help with technology. You will be expected to complete homework, coursework and other learning activities outside of the classroom. Learning Mentors are on hand to help you with your academic study skills or any further catch up work you might need.

7. INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT (ID)

The College ID programmes aim is to build the behaviours, attitudes, and personal skills you will need to thrive in both work and society. 
LEARNING SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS WITH SEND/ADDITIONAL NEEDS





Bricklayers build houses, repair walls and chimneys and refurbish decorative stonework. They also work on restoration projects.

SALARIES: range from £17,000 to £40,000 a year dependent on experience.

In your day-to-day tasks you could:

- Measure work areas and set out the first rows of bricks or blocks.



We create an individual programme of study, which considers each student's needs and aspirations. We take a holistic and learner-focused approach to ensuring that our students' experiences, achievements and outcomes are outstanding and sustainable. All students on a Foundation Learning programme will have an assigned personal tutor who will work with the student to co-create their timetable.






